Outdoor Education & Leadership Emphasis (18 hours)

The Outdoor Education & Leadership (OEL) emphasis area prepares students for rewarding positions in the outdoor recreation field. Students will finish the program with a Wilderness First Responder Certification from the Wilderness Medicine Institute (WMI); a Leave No Trace Master Educator Certification from the National Outdoor Leadership School (NOLS) and an Outdoor Education & Leadership Certificate from NAU.

In order to be admitted to the Milestone OEL PRM Emphasis you must complete the following pre-requisites & online application form:

General Prerequisites:

- Registering as a PRM major in Louie.
- Declare Outdoor Education & Leadership Emphasis area in Louie.

OEL pre-requisite requirements with a grade of "C" or better:

- PRM 216 Wilderness First Responder (3)
- PRM 331: Outdoor Leader Certification I (3)
- OEL Online Application

A NOLS "Outdoor Educator Semester" course will meet the requirements for the Outdoor Education & Leadership Emphasis with the addition of electives equal to 21 credit hours
